## Town of Moorcroft Special Meeting of the Council Thursday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019

**Town Council Present:** Clerk/Treasurer Cheryl Schneider, Officer Bill Bryant, and Public Works Director Cory Allison

Mayor Claar called the meeting to order at 6:05 pm and the Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Call for Bids for the Town Hall and the lots north of town hall were discussed. Discussion was had on the options for the Call for Bids as selling the Town Hall or selling separately.

Councilman Mathews motioned to advertise the Call for Bids for the Town Hall and the lots north of Town Hall as listed in the Call for Bids description, removing the \$500 minimum acceptable bid, to declare the deadline for the bids as 5:00 pm on November 25<sup>th</sup> and to open the bids received by the declared deadline at 7:00 pm the same date at the Regular Meeting of the Council and Councilman Smoot seconded. Motion carried 5/0.

Cory discussed some of the town's projects he has prioritized for the upcoming future. He stated the roads need to be continued, drain work in the alleys, parking lot at MTC needs to have new asphalt. Councilman Glenn stated preplanning a bathroom at Noonan Park should be added to the list. Councilman Petersen discussed the need for some road work at the cemetery and if he could add that to the priority list. Council discussed working on some of the road at the cemetery right away and to start with the first 300 feet. Councilman Petersen motioned to work on the improvement of the cemetery and to use 3<sup>rd</sup> specific funds and Councilman Smoot seconded. Motion carried 5/0.

Clerk Schneider went over the quarterly budget report and updated the monies left in the specific purpose account to date. She answered questions Council had on the report.

Council discussed paving alternatives on Goshen and Park while the Powder River Sewer project is going on. Councilman Glenn motioned to temporarily pave Goshen and Park with hard surface until the project funding comes through and Council Smoot seconded. Motion carried 5/0.

Councilman Glenn motioned to include the concrete paving on Campbell and using 3<sup>rd</sup> specific funds and Councilman Mathews seconded. Motion carried 5/0.

With no further business to discuss, Councilman Petersen motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:28 and Councilman Glenn seconded. Motion carried 5/0.
