

**RESOLUTION NO. 3-2019  
TOWN OF MOORCROFT  
FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

**Whereas,** The Town of Moorcroft recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

**Whereas,** undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

**Whereas,** the U.S. Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 ("Disaster Mitigation Act") emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards;

**Whereas,** the Disaster Mitigation Act made available hazard mitigation grants to state and local governments;

**Whereas;** an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

**Whereas;** the Town of Moorcroft fully participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

**Whereas,** The Wyoming Office of Homeland Security and the Federal Emergency Management Agency Region VIII officials have reviewed the **FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**, and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body;

**Whereas,** the Town of Moorcroft desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the **FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**.

**Whereas, adoption** by the governing body for the Town of Moorcroft demonstrates the jurisdiction commitment to fulfilling the mitigation goals and objectives outlined in this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan.

**Whereas,** adoption of this legitimacies the plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the plan.

**Now, therefore, be it resolved,** that the Town of Moorcroft adopts the **FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**.
