Monday, March 22, 2021

Town Council Present: Mayor Dick Claar, Councilmen Ben Glenn, Austin Smith, Paul Smoot and Dale Petersen

Town Employees Present: Deputy Clerk Jodi Clark, Police Chief Bill Bryant, HDR Engineers Heath Turbiville and Jeron Smith

Mayor Claar called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and the Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Councilman Glenn motioned to go into Executive Session to discuss Personnel. Councilman Smoot 2nd. 5/0 motion passed.

Council reconvened at 6:51 from the Executive Session with no action taken. At this time a break will be taken until the meeting time of 7:00.

They will redoing a portion of Highway 14 North in 2025 and is asking if the Town of Moorcroft if there would be any interest from the Town to partake and do a coop with the State to do any work in the Town while the equipment is local to save some money. Council will review the options and let them know in regards to the options.

Dan Blakeman and Charlie Britton were present to discuss the recommendations they have put together for the council. These recommendations were in regard to the fees of the rentals and also the Wyoming energy light grant. The recommendations that were presented on the grant, the council would like to have a different approach looked at, with an additional recommendation presented with the results of the cost.


