Sec. 10-101. Uniform Housing Code—Adoption.

There is hereby adopted by the Town, for the purpose of prescribing regulations for the minimum standards to safeguard life, health, property and public welfare, the Uniform Housing Code, being particularly the 1973 edition thereof and the whole thereof, save and except such portions as are modified, deleted, added or amended pursuant to the provisions of Section 10-102, and the same is hereby incorporated in this section as fully as if set out at length herein and the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the Town.

Sec. 10-102. Uniform Housing Code—Amendments, modifications, additions and deletions.

The Code adopted by Section 10-101 shall have such amendments, modifications, additions or deletions as the Town Council shall, from time to time, adopt by ordinance.

Sec. 10-103. Uniform Housing Code—Filing and availability of Code and amendments.

At least one (1) copy of the Code adopted by Section 10-101 and any ordinance providing for amendments, modifications, additions or deletions in such Code (adopted by the Town Council) shall be maintained on file in the office of the Town Clerk where they shall be available for public inspection during the normal office hours of the Town Clerk. One (1) copy of each ordinance amending or modifying such Code shall be kept with each copy of such Code and made available for public inspection at the same time as and in the same manner as such Code.
