**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF
APPLICATION TO THE WYOMING BUSINESS COUNCIL
UNDER THE BUILDING RESILIENT COMMUNITIES GRANT
AND LOAN PROGRAM FOR A GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE
GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MOORCROFT**

**FOR THE PURPOSE OF: EXTENDING SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE NORTH
OF INTERSTATE 90 IN THE AREA OF LINCOLN STREET**

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Moorcroft desires to participate in the Building Resilient Communities Grant and Loan Program to assist in financing this project; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Moorcroft recognizes the lack of public sewer infrastructure north of Interstate 90 has limited housing and business development opportunities within the community. Extending sanitary sewer service will remove a significant infrastructure barrier, improve site readiness and make developed and developable property available for future investment and economic growth; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Moorcroft recognizes the need to provide adequate public utility infrastructure to support existing businesses, encourage housing development and accommodate future community growth and believes this project will address those needs; and

WHEREAS, the public benefit(s) of this project will include: expansion of public infrastructure to support housing development; increase availability to future land development; expansion of local tax base; increased utility service capacity; increasing opportunities for workforce and family housing; and enhancing the Town's ability to attract new investment, and the consideration is linear feet of sewer main constructed; number of acres made serviceable by public sewer; potential housing development made possible by the project; future utility connections available; and

WHEREAS, the specific goals and measures of success of this project are: complete construction of the sewer extension as designed; eliminate infrastructure barriers for development north of Interstate 90; support future residential growth; improve the Town's long-term economic sustainability; and

WHEREAS, the Building Resilient Communities Grant and Loan Program requires that certain criteria be met, as described in the Wyoming Business Council's Rules governing the program, and to the best of our knowledge this application meets those criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Moorcroft plans to provide cash match to this Building Resilient Communities Grant and Loan Program from the following source(s): Specific Purpose Tax funds, Sewer Enterprise Funds or other legally available funding sources approved by the Governing Body; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body for the Town of Moorcroft has a comprehensive operation and maintenance plan including projected expenses and project income sources extending the life of the asset(s); and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body for the Town of Moorcroft will use the revenue recaptured from this project for the following economic development purposes: Revenue generated through future utility connections and service fees will be reinvested into operation, maintenance, replacement, and expansion of the Town's wastewater infrastructure to support continued economic development and community growth.

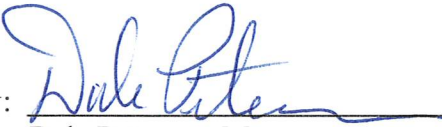
WHEREAS, in the event of any project cost overruns, the Town of Moorcroft will provide funding in the amount necessary to complete the project utilizing Specific Purpose Tax revenue, Sewer Enterprise Funds or other legally available funding sources approved by the Governing Body; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body for the Town of Moorcroft has considered other possible funding solutions for this project which include other state and federal grants, local private match or in-kind options; and

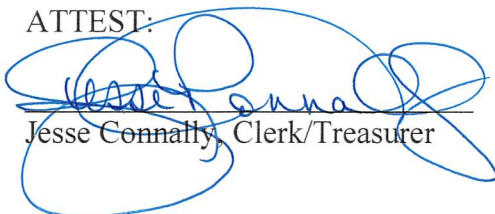
WHEREAS, the Town of Moorcroft held a public hearing on June 22nd, 2026 to solicit testimony from citizens, and gave full consideration to all comments received; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MOORCROFT, that a grant application in the amount of \$1,632,851.25 be submitted to the Wyoming Business Council for consideration of assistance in funding the Lincoln Street Sewer Line Project.
