

## REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

Tuesday, June 25, 2013

Mayor Steve Blakeman called the Regular Council Meeting to order at 7:00 pm on Tuesday June 25, 2013. Council members present were Owen Mathews, Fred Devish, and Ben Glenn. Dale Petersen was absent. Visitors present were Justin Bailey, Sharon Campbell, and Kari Donner.

Visitor Kari Donner made request to be appointed to the Rec. Board. Councilman Glenn made motion to appoint Kari Donner to the Rec. Board Devish 2<sup>nd</sup> all ayes, motion carried.

Visitor Sharon Campbell requested on July 12, 2013 that the Robinson Road from Yellowstone to Big Horn and a portion of South Big Horn from the Flagpole to Railroad be closed from 5:30 pm – 9:30 pm and on Saturday July 13, 2013 that South Big Horn from Converse to Railroad be closed from 3:30 pm – 3:30 am. Sharon also requested that the Open Container Ordinance be relaxed from the hours of 8:00 am July 13<sup>th</sup> till 6:00 am Sunday July 14<sup>th</sup>. Councilman Devish made motion for street closures for July 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> Glenn 2<sup>nd</sup> all ayes, motion carried. Councilman Mathews made motion to relax Open container Ordinance from 8 am July 13<sup>th</sup> till 6:00am July 14<sup>th</sup> Devish 2<sup>nd</sup> all ayes, motion carried.

Visitor Justin Bailey discussed the new location for the Vendors Permit he had submitted for the FFA Fireworks stand located at Coffee Cup Fuel Stop. He also requested that the Fireworks Ordinance be relaxed from July 2, 2013 through July 6<sup>th</sup> from the hours of 10am – 10pm on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup>, and from 10am- 12am on the 4<sup>th</sup>. Councilman Mathews made motion to relax the Fireworks Ordinance from July 2<sup>nd</sup> – July 6<sup>th</sup> with the hours requested Glenn 2<sup>nd</sup> all ayes, motion carried. Councilman Mathews made motion to approve FFA's permit to sell fireworks Devish 2<sup>nd</sup> all ayes, motion carried.

Councilman Mathews made motion to approve Regular Council Meeting Minutes from June 10<sup>th</sup> Devish 2<sup>nd</sup> all ayes, motion carried.

Councilman Glenn had a question on Heritage Homes Bill. The bill was reduced to \$1,787.00. Councilman Mathews made motion to approve June bill list 2 Glenn 2<sup>nd</sup> all ayes, motion carried.

No Clerk report.

Bill Carson with HDR Engineering gave his report. Carson explained that how after the old Maintenance shop is demolished the land will be surveyed before is put up for sale. Carson gave an update on the work with Hardrives construction and that the job is 60% complete and that the Chip sealing will start July 1, 2013. Carson also brought a pay request in the amount of \$108,103.19 for the work that Hardrive has completed. Councilman Mathews made motion to approve pay request for \$108,103.19 Glenn 2<sup>nd</sup> all ayes, motion carried.

Town Administrator Dan Blakeman gave his report. Blakeman let the Mayor and Council Members know that there will be a NEWY meeting in Sundance Wednesday night if anyone could make it.
