Wednesday, September 14, 2016

Town Council Present: Mayor Pro-Tem Dick Claar, Councilmen Mathews, Glenn and Councilman Aloisio via phone. Mayor Steve Sproul absent.

Town Employees Present: Clerk/Treasurer Cheryl Schneider

Mayor Pro-Tem Dick Claar called the meeting to order at 4:46 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance said.

New Business:

The bid that for the public works department pickup that was approved at Monday, September 12th council meeting came in without a surety bond and cannot be accepted. **Councilman Aloisio motioned to rescind the bid that was accepted from Bob Ruwart Motors on Monday, September 12th council meeting because it did not meet the standards and Councilman Mathews seconded. Motion carried 4/0. Councilman Mathews motioned to accept the bid from Fremont Motors for \$29991.00 for the pickup and Councilman Glenn seconded. Councilman Mathews amended his motion that the funds come from where the line item was previously designated. Motion carried 4/0.**


Discussion was had on the quotes for the bathroom roof at Robinson Park. The town has only received one quote. It is for \$2,195.00 from Glenn Construction. **Councilman Mathews motioned to approve the quote for the replacement of the roof on Robinson bathrooms and Councilman Aloisio seconded. Councilman Glenn abstained. Motion carried 4/0.**

Clerk Schneider discussed with the council credit card procedures and fees. The town cannot continue to absorb the fees for the credit card use and the fee has to be passed on to the customer. Options would be set up for the customers on our website to pay by check or credit card for those who wish to use their credit cards. Customers would be encouraged to set up automatic bank withdraws or continue to pay by check or cash at the window to eliminate any additional fees. The public will be notified for two weeks of the changes. **Councilman Mathews motioned to continue to accept credit cards at the window until the target date of October 1st and then to eliminate accepting credit cards at the window and having an online option in place or continuing to be in place along with automatic account deduction and Councilman Aloisio seconded. Councilman Mathews amended his motion by adding not accepting credit cards over the phone and Councilman Aloisio amended his second. Motion carried 4/0.**

With no further business, **Councilman Mathews motioned to adjourn the meeting and Councilman Glenn seconded. Motion carried 4/0.**
