

ORDINANCE NO. 2-1991 – ENTITLED

TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 2-201

**REVISION OF TITLE 2, ANIMALS AND FOWL, CHAPTER 2, KEEPING OF
CERTAIN LIVESTOCK WITHIN THE TOWN OF MOORCROFT,
FORBIDDEN, SECTION 2-201.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
MOORCROFT, CROOK COUNTY, WYOMING.**

2-201 –

**A – KEEPING OF CERTAIN LIVESTOCK WITHIN THE TOWN OF
MOORCROFT, FORBIDDEN** – It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep within the Town of Moorcroft, any swine, chickens, geese, or other poultry, or any cows, goats, sheep or livestock; and any person or persons, firm or corporation, keeping or maintaining such animal or animals within the said town, shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of maintaining a nuisance, and shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each offence together with the cost of action, provided, however, that this ordinance shall not apply to any animal hospital.

B – VARIANCE – Request for variances from this ordinance shall be made in writing and presented to the Town Council. Requests shall state the nature of the requested variance and the reason for the variance. Variances shall be approved or denied only by majority vote of the Town Council.

Since an emergency exists, this ordinance shall be full force and effect from and after its approval, passage, and adoption as by law required and all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
